



## **RETHOUGHT RAILS - Another stash buster quilt**

Finished quilt size  $-57" \times 76"$  Block size -9 %" finished Finished quilt with 2" border  $-61" \times 80"$ 

-You will need a total of 12 cuts of featured fabrics, cut 6" x wof. Each design will have a different number of individual fabrics to cut. -Sashing strips are cut @ 2 ½" x wof. You will need 24 strips (60")

- a strip is sewn to each side of the featured fabric strips.

-If you wish to add a border, cut an additional 7 strips, an additional 18" Total, 2 ¼ yds.

Cut  $\underline{12}$  different strips of theme fabric @6" x wof. If you are stash busting, you can cut anything that measures 6" x 10" or 20" or 30".

Sew a sashing strip to each side of the feature fabric. Press the seam allowances to the sashing. Trim selvages. Cut at 10". You need a total of 48 blocks. Make a pleasing arrangement of colors and prints and sew the blocks as per the top diagram.

## FOR A 2 FABRIC SETTING

Cut <u>6</u> strips of one feature fabric and 6 strips of another feature fabric. Place all of one fabric blocks into the vertical positions and all of the other fabric blocks into the horizontal positions as per the middle diagram.

## DIAGONAL SETTING

Cut <u>2</u> strips of <u>6</u> theme fabrics. These 2 strips will yield 8 blocks. Set them diagonally, following the numbers on the blocks. Each number is a different shade but it is hard to tell the shadings apart.
