Frolicking Felines Supply List

- Portable Palette by Jinny Beyer - optional (palettes will be available for use in class)
- Paper
- Tracing paper
- Colored pencils
- Fabric: a multicolored piece from your stash
- Basic sewing kit
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
- Pigma pen: Black, 0.01 micron
- Thread: 100% sewing cotton to match fabric values
- Sewing machine in good working order, manual
- Extension cord and power strip
- Iron and ironing board (*the Guild will provide some irons and boards to share*)

Fabric:

Ah, the choices.... This quilt block lends itself to at least four variations:

1. Nine patch with two colors
2. Simple shading from light to dark of six fabrics (it could be more, if you like) in one color family
3. Simple shading from light to dark in alternating rows of two color families
4. Complete color study as in the sample. The sample uses 6" x 6" pieces of 60 different fabrics (10 color families shaded light to dark).

You would need 1/8 yard of each fabric. There are two sizes of blocks to choose from (2" and 3") so not much fabric is needed. It depends on the size quilt you would like to make. Bring extra fabric to play with.
