Mystery Quilt: The Case of the Stretched Chains – Supply List

Everyone loves a mystery, so come and join in the fun. When you “solve” the mystery, you will have a 52” X 76” quilt and a story to tell.

Supplies:

Fabric--

2 and 2/3 yard Background fabric (tone on tone is best here). *If you normally use a white or beige background be adventurous and try a dark such as black, brown or navy.*

14 assorted Fat Quarters (all similar value)

Nine one-quart Ziplock bags

Sewing thread (beige, black or white, whichever is most appropriate for your fabrics)

Before coming to class:

- Label the nine plastic bags with black marker: Clue #1, Clue #2, etc.
- Cut fabric and place in the numbered baggies as you cut them:

Clue #1: Assorted Fabrics, Cut 12 strips, 2.5” X Fat Quarter

Clue #2: Background Fabric: Cut 14 strips, 4.5” X 45”

Assorted Fabrics: Cut 10 strips, 2.5” X Fat Quarter

Clue #3: Background Fabric: Cut 3 strips, 8.5” X Fat Quarter

Assorted Fabric: Cut 10 strips, 2.5” X FQ

Clue #4: Assorted Fabrics: Cut 20 strips, 2.5” X Fat Quarter

Clue #5: Background Fabric: Cut 6 strips, 4.5” X 45”

Clue #6: Background Fabric: Cut 4 strips, 2.5” X 45”

Clue #7: Assorted Fabrics: Cut 16 strips, 2.5” X 45” (or cut 32 strips 2.5 X FQ)

Clue #8: ??

Clue #9: Background Fabric: Cut 3 strips 2.5” X 45”

Bring with you to class:

Sewing machine and supplies

Rotary cutting supplies

Fabric cut in baggies

Sewing thread
