SUPPLY LIST

Supplies needed: (available at your local quilt shop or through www.bobkatquilts.com. I can ship them to you or we can arrange for local pickup prior to class date.) Registered students will receive a 10% discount on pattern and supplies purchased through BobKat Quilts. Once registered, you will receive the coupon code necessary to use at checkout at the BobKat website.

- Pattern: Quiltworx Compass Rose
- 6" or 12" Add-A-Quarter Ruler
- 12" – 18" Ruler
- Fabric Glue Pen (small diameter) – water soluble
- Flower Pins
- Purple Thang
- Microtex Sharp Needles (size 70)
- Gallon sized Zip closed bags (just 2 or 3)

- Medium sized cutting mat (18" x 24")
- Rotary Cutter with new blade
- Sewing machine with BOTH open toe and 1/4" sewing feet
- Regular sewing supplies



Personal Pressing Mat (suggested)
Personal Small Iron (suggested – not Clover mini)

BE SURE TO SEE PAGE 2 – PRE-CLASS PREPARATION



Pre-Class Preparation:

1. Have all supplies as noted on the Registration materials.
2. Have all fabrics pressed and make note which color you want where in your design. See the chart below to help with fabric selection.
3. Read the instructions thoroughly – but do NOT cut your fabrics until class.
4. Visit the Quiltworx website (www.quiltworx.com) and click on Products → Corrections and print out the corrections for the Compass Rose pattern. Compare the corrections to your pattern and make notes (if necessary) of the changes. *NOTE: Your pattern may be from a later printing and thus the corrections have already been made. But it is important to ALWAYS check for corrections before beginning your project!*
5. Take one (1) TP103 Layout sheet and two (2) NP206 Unit A sheets (the remaining sheets are for a second table runner) and cut out the templates and foundations. ***Cut around the outside edge of each unit 1/8" away from the perimeter lines. Do not cut on or across any of the printed lines on your papers!!!*** Please do not cut ON ANY OF THE LINES at this time... nor should you cut much beyond 1/8" as that can actually make the sewing process a little more complicated.

Fabrics for foundation paper piecing: (Border, Backing and Binding fabrics are not included in this list)

- Color #1 - Background (fabrics with small scale designs or harmonious transitions work best)
- Color #2 - Accent (small center flower points – red in the image below)
- Color #3 - Accent (flower petals – green in the image below)
- Color #4 - Accent (flower base – small white triangle in the image below)
- Color #5 - Accent (short spike – light red /gray in image – can use a single color)
- Color #6 - Accent (long center spike – dark red in image)
- Color #7 - Accent (long center spike – yellow in image)
