Supply List and Class Prep

★ Each student must have a copy of Lines by Design Quilts by Debbie Grifka. Debbie will have books available for purchase the day of class for \$20.

Class supplies:

¼" foot and see-through appliqué or satin stitch foot
Thread to match fabrics for piecing and appliqué
Fine tip permanent marker such as Sharpie
Sewing machine and usual supplies
Ruler, rotary cutter and mat (optional)

Clerestory quilt:

Finished quilt size: 64" x 74" - finished block size: 10" x 15"

Fabric requirements for the whole quilt:

Print #1: 1 yard (blocks and binding)

Print #2: ⅓ yard

Green solid: ⅓ yard

Curry solid: ½ yard

Navy solid: ½ yard

Background: 4¾ yards

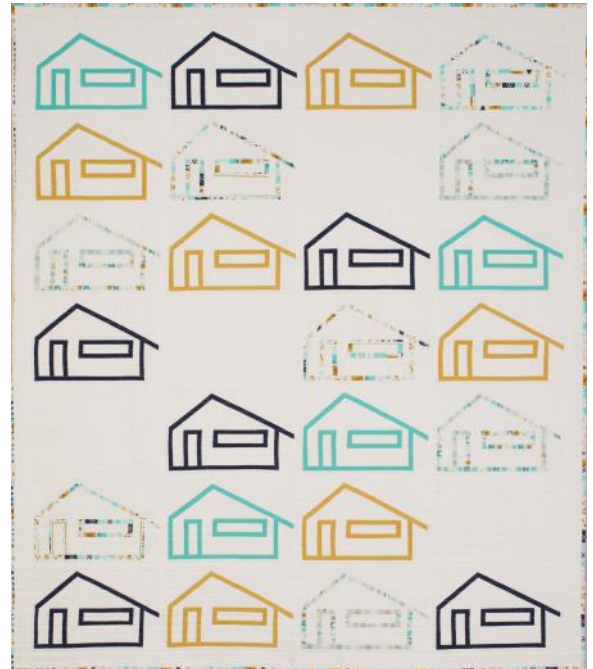
Backing: 4 yards

Other Supplies:

Batting: 70" x 80"

Fusible web: 2 yards (I use Heat-N-Bond Lite)

Stabilizer (optional): 2 yards (I use Stitch-N-Tear)



★ To save class time, please cut out the following from one fabric (either print or the green solid) and background. This will be enough to make four blocks. I suggest keeping your pieces organized by letter in plastic baggies.

Cut from either print or the green solid:

Cut a 10" WOF* strip. Cut a 16" Z piece for the appliqué. Cut the remaining piece into 1" strips and subcut into 4 12¾" Y pieces, 8 6½" W pieces, 8 4½" X pieces, 8 4" T pieces, 4 2½" U pieces and 8 1½" V pieces.

Cut from the background: (all strips cut WOF*)

Cut 1 14½" strip; subcut 4 5½" x 14½" G pieces

Cut 1 2½" strip; subcut 4 6½" D pieces

Cut 1 2¼" strip, subcut into 4 5" F pieces

Cut 1 1¾" strip; subcut into 8 4½" A pieces

Cut 1 1½" strip; subcut into 4 5½" C pieces and 4 4" B pieces

Cut 1 1¼" strip; subcut into 4 4½" E pieces

Cut 4 1" strips; subcut into 4 15½" I pieces and 8 10" H pieces
