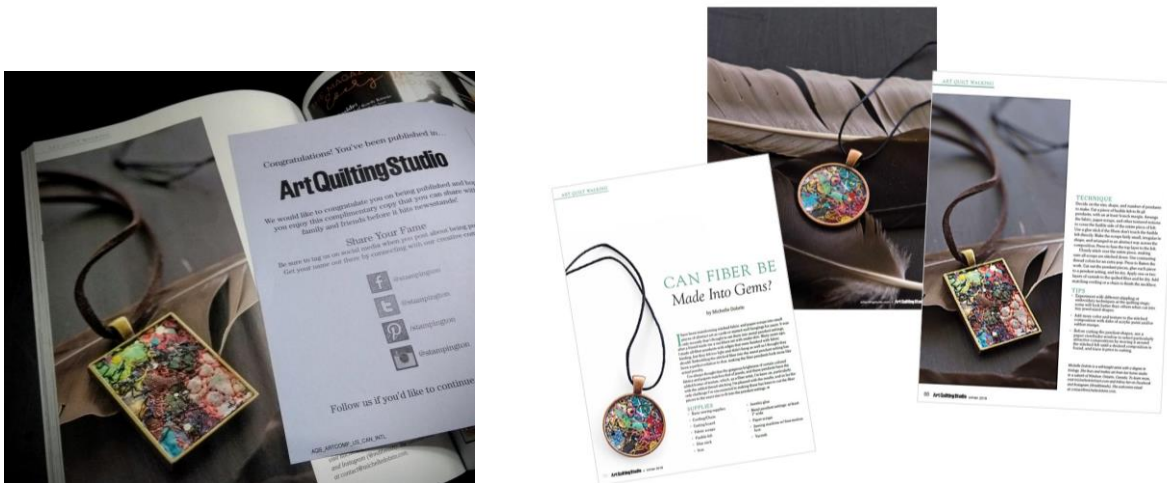


Fiber Gems Stitched Pendants (1-day class):

Learn to create fiber gems by stitching tiny quilts and setting them into metal pendants. Using bits of fabrics, fibers and recycled paper scraps, attendees will arrange them in abstract designs and free-motion quilt them, then cut them into tiny (~1 inch) pieces to glue to metal pendants and hang them from necklaces. Multiple pendants will be made by each attendee, and in multiple sizes and shapes (square, oval, rectangular, circular).

Class kit (\$15) includes the following materials:

- 4 metal pendant settings in different shapes, dimensions, colours
- cording (enough to hang 4 necklaces)

Class supply list:

- Metal pendant settings (suggested 5-10; as many as desired, in addition to the 4 provided)
- Necklace chains and/or cords to hang pendants (suggested 5-10)
- Fusible fleece (or felt, at least 2-3mm in thickness)
- Scraps of fabric, paper, embellishments in various colours and textures
- Thread, assorted types and colours
- Tweezers (for handling small bits of fabric, etc)
- Jewelry glue
- Glue stick, Pens, markers
- Sewing machine; cutting, sewing tools, etc
- Beads and other notions (optional)
- Acrylic or Fabric paints, Glitter glue (optional)
- Varnish or fabric sealant
