

## Lynn Krawczyk Tiny Textile Treasures Supply List

**Description:** This class challenges the textile artist to work not small, but TINY! During our time together we will work on a series of 4" square textile collages.

Morning portion of class: Students will focus on creating a series of Tiny Textiles based on timed prompts. The confines of the small surface and limited time will nurture the student's ability to follow her artist instincts instead of overthinking options. These exercises will provide the backgrounds of each Tiny Textile

Afternoon portion of class: Now we add the fabulous details! Students will explore creating a cohesive composition by adding details using pens, markers, hand stitching, beading and unexpected elements such as paper and metal!

Display options will also be shown in class so you can decide how to show off your new art!

### **Supply List:**

\* 4" squares of felt – please pre-cut before class so we can get straight to creating! I would bring at least 12 squares but feel free to bring extras. I use craft acrylic that you can buy by the yard, it does not need to be anything expensive.

\* Pins and/or binder clips – These are so small that we don't need to fuse them to the felt

\* Fabric pens and markers. Definitely bring black but the rest of the colors are up to you.

\* Scrap fabric! Put them to work! If you have hand print fabric and have fabric that you hate, bring it to this class. You'll be amazed at how well it incorporates into smaller works.

\* Fabric glue stick. Don't bring liquid, we will be using this very sparingly. Lynn will have a couple for class use.

\* Embellishments that you love: beads, buttons, trims. Anything goes!

\* Hand embroidery threads and embroidery needles. *If you do not want to stitch your treasures by hand, feel free to bring a sewing machine. However, be aware that sewing machines and Lynn argue frequently so she won't be able to assist you with any issues of it's operation.*

\* Scissors

\* One or two irons/ironing pads or boards for class use, it's not necessary for everyone to bring an iron/ironing pad.

\* Lynn will also have various items for class use such as stencils, stamps, fabric paint and scrap fabrics.

### **Kit Fee: \$12**

**Kit includes:** Thread Tasting Bundle (a curated variety of different brands and styles of hand embroidery thread, 5 yards total), embroidery needle, hand dyed embellishments such as lace and trim. Lynn will also have a large selection of paper images that you can use in your work, you will get to choose your own as part of your kit.
