

It has something to do with light refraction, blah, blah, blah. Today it is 91 outside so this quilt is especially pleasing to look at, from afar, but from under.

Started in a fusible appliqué class with Frieda Anderson in January 2016. Finally finished July 2020!

Sunrise Over Orient Beach 43.5 x 34 Wall

This was based on a photo I took of a sunrise over Orient Beach in St Martin. It was inspired by a small group challenge to incorporate paper. The quilt includes commercial fabrics and my own hand dyed fabric. I used paper in the clouds to create transparency.

Maker - Ilene Harris Quilter - Ilene Harris

Monet Challenge 24 x 32 Monet Challenge

I belong to a small GAAQG group. We used Monet's "Water Lilies" to inspire our quilts. I didn't try to duplicate the artwork, but let the color, shapes, style, etc. influence/inspire the quilt creation. I started with a jelly roll that reminded me of water. Then I layered netting. The lilies were made with a square of fabric, yarn (which my cat help arrange) and buttons.

Maker - Lucinda Herring Quilter - Lucinda Herring

70 x 70 Chas's Blue Rescue Rescue 9-1-1

I bought the blue whirly gig blocks (ca 1910-20) at an estate sale. I found the 9 patch quilt with the red sashing (ca 1920) covering a car motor outside in the UP. I gave the guy \$5 for it. The flying geese blocks were made from my 80's stash.

Maker - Lucinda Herring Quilter - Lucinda Herring

Deconstructed 9 Patch 62 x 62 Rescue 9-1-1

Not all yellow fabric is pretty. I bought the original quilt for \$15. I got rid of all the dirty and shredded yellow fabric. I had my daughter draft out my idea for the design and made sure I had enough 9 patches that were usable. I only had a few left over.

Maker - Lucinda Herring Quilter - Lucinda Herring

64 x 54 Andrew's Blue Rescue Rescue 9-1-1

The string pieced quilt (ca 1920) was purchased for \$10. I never had any doubt I was making half square triangles and I used the original quilt back for the blocks. It was my husbands's idea to put all the blocks with red in one row. This quilt is hanging in my son's house.

Maker - Lucinda Herring Quilter - Lucinda Herring

The Circus Quilt 95 at the widest point Rescue 9-1-1

The original quilt had zig zag ruffled borders. My daughter drafted it to be a hexagon. We deconstructed what blocks we needed to. I appliquéd a new zig zag border (324').

Block Lotto #1 65 x 49 Rescue 9-1-1

I bought some 9 patch blocks from an estate sale that had been done by a small group from the guild. Fabrics from the 1990s. I sliced and diced and added the star block -also from the block lotto group.

Circus Balloons for Charlie 42 x 50 Rescue 9-1-1

I made some of the leftover hexies from the Circus Quilt into circles for my new grandson's quilt.

Drunken Fans 60 x 60 Rescue 9-1-1

The original quilt had a horrible green border and boring setting. My daughter arranged the blocks for me, but I would be one short. So I made one more block from fabric left from dresses I had made her.

Beach Glass 110 x 99 Rescue 9-1-1

A few estate sale quilt discoveries, at a cost of a few dollars, supplied the blocks for this quilt. The original quilts were damaged and had awful batting. Following a long session with a small rotary cutter, the salvaged blocks, less some that were too light or dark or not a good match for this project, were rearranged. Since the colors of the blocks resembled those of Lake Superior beach glass, the quilt's name was born.

Maker - Lucinda Herring Quilter - Lucinda Herring

70 x 70 **Create Your Own Constellation** Rescue 9-1-1

Someone gifted me the original quilt. The blocks were many sizes (5 1/4"-7 1/2"). I started in the top left because those blocks were mostly the same size. Fabrics 1900-1920.

Moorestown Modern #1 72 x 72 Wall

The pattern was from Heather Jone's class on big blocks. The scrappy crazy quilt blocks are from 40's-50's fabrics.

I cut about 3400 masks during the stay at home order, which produced a lot of scraps. This was made from one of Mary Hogan's books. I gave it to the woman at my church who organized the making of over 2100 masks.

Mask Scraps #1 54 x 64.5 Wall

My church had 2 large donations to purchase fabric to make masks. I cut over 3,000. I was very careful how I cut them so I had good 'scraps' left. This pattern was in a 2016 Modern Quilt Magazine. It will be raffled in the fall, with proceeds going to the mission team at Shalom Lutheran Church in Pinckney.



Maker - Marion Holt Quilter - Marion Holt

Bargello Fantasy 29.5 x 46 Wall

I took on this project as a challenge. I loved the movement in it. Using colors from the southwest, where we lived at the time. It became a bright bit of sunshine in our house.

Wave Action 15 x 37 Wall

Found this pattern in a magazine and was intrigued by its movement. Loving bright colors, I chose to give it an eye-catching array of fabrics.

Maker - Laura Jarvis Quilter - Laura Jarvis, Kootsi Quilting 80 x 95 City Quilt

"City Green" from the book "City Quilts" by Cherri House. Batting: Quilters Dream Orient (bamboo & silk). Stitched on a HandiQuilter Infinity, stitch design by Anne Bright "Circuit Path," thread: Superior Threads Omni 3024, medium gray. My favorite color is green, the color of spring and I was gifted a huge stash of wonderful fabric, so it was an easy step to make this guilt (for myself!).

Maker - Kathy Johnson Quilter - Kathy Johnson

Vermont Barn Timber 48 x 48 Wall

Using an interior barn photo of a timber with mortise taken by my husband as inspiration, this original design was created in a Heather Jones class.

Maker - Anne Kehn Quilter - Laura Jarvis, Kootsi Quilting **Great Waves** 60 x 80 Bed

This quilt features fabric that mimics the Great Wave of Kanagawa, a Japanese woodblock print. Combined with the gold highlighted cranes, it is reminiscent of a wonderful culture. It is made with the rows pattern shared during a guild SafeHouse sewing event.

Maker - Ann Kehn Quilter - Laura Jarvis, Kootsi Quilting Hawaii's Oceans: Whales, Fish & Corals 60 x 80 Bed

Hawaii's Oceans uses fabrics that are mindful of the natural beauty around Hawaii. It uses bright colors to bring out the incredible diversity of the Pacific Ocean. This quilt uses a modified rows pattern that was shared at a SafeHouse sewing event.

Maker - Ann Kehn Quilter - Laura Jarvis, Kootsi Quilting **Bright Coral** 60 x 80 Bed

A bright quilt using sunny yellow and sea coral. Quilting pattern of crazy 8's highlights the circles in the pink fabric and the rainbow backing. Rows pattern shared at the SafeHouse sewing event.

Aztec Fun used fabrics found at the SafeHouse Fabric table that had markings reminiscent of Aztec culture. The straight line shapes of the quilting pattern further highlight the fun nature of this quilt. The row pattern was shared at a Safe House sewing event.

Astrid's Stringtime Quilt 🔷 60 x 80 Bed

This is my grand-daughter's Astrid's quilt. She lives in Madison WI. I made this quilt using the string piecing technique I learned from Mary Hogan. The sawtooth border was inspired by a class I took from Lynn Harris last May 2019. My grand-daughter helped me in selecting and putting together a number of the strips for the blocks. She had a hand in some of the final design by helping me decide on sashing (or not). She also picked out the final border fabric from a group that I auditioned. Sandy McCoy of Grass Lake quilted it for me on her long arm. I loved the way it turned out. And, so did Astrid.

Maker - Erika Keith Quilter - Erika Keith

Ancestor Chair Triptych 8.5 x 16.5 ea Wall

This trio was a group challenge -choose a subject and depict it in 3 styles, realistic, stylized and abstract. My subject, a chair photographed on the island of St. Lucia.

Maker - Michele Kennedy Quilter - Michele Kennedy

Newest Neighbor Quilt 47 x 47 Bed

Made for the new baby on our condo cul de sac. Buildings represent our units. Square blocks in middle have messages. Embellished with machine decorative stitches inspired by "Two Flowers" class.

Maker - Michele Kennedy Quilter - Michele Kennedy

A Walk in the Woods 20 x 17 Wall

Small group challenge: unusual material. I used plastic screening, tea bags, embossed paper, sheer pleated fabric, upholstery samples, and multi fiber yarn.

28 x 39 Columbine Wall

I love Ruth McDowell's work. I went to the Quilters Hall of Fame where she was quilter of the year, took a master class, and saw a gallery exhibition of her well known quilts. This quilt was pieced by her methods.

Pincushion Collage 30 x 30 Wall

My version of a Laura Heine pattern entered with her permission. It was made for a friend's retirement and 65th birthday. It was so much fun adding the little details.

Feathered Friend 34 x 34 Wall

This original design is my third quilt with birds as a theme. This quilt was made as part of the Paradigm Quilters fabric challenge. The leaves, the colorful background bricks, and most of the birds were all cut from a Marcia Derse fabric called "Treasure Hunt".



Maker - Arlene Kindell Quilter - Laura Jarvis, Kootsi Quilting Frida 64 x 84 Bed

This quilt began with a pile of scraps that were "too good to throw out", and, for once, having time at home to sew. I tried randomly piecing it together to make a larger piece, and it soon turned into making blocks. As it turned out, many of the blocks had bits that reminded me of Mexico, including three that have Frida Kahlo in them, hence the name "Frida".

This guilt used partial blocks and strips left over from another project. I played around with the pieces until it formed a pattern, then added more strips and blocks to make it big enough.

This quilt is the result of a quilt top that was "rescued" (maker unknown). The original top needed some repair, and some borders were needed to increase the size.

Milicent's Garden 50 x 70 0 Bed

Jane Sassaman lectured and taught for GAAQG sometime early in this century. I took her class and was hooked on her designs, patterns, and fabric. Marilyn Knepp Quilter - Marilyn Knepp

fREADom 12 x 12 Wall

Made for a good friend's mother—a retired librarian— and gifted during ALA's 2019 banned books week. All the books in the quilt are on their list of those most frequently banned. Remember: "Google can bring you back 100,000 answers, a librarian can bring you back the right one." - Neil Gaiman. fREADom from Patrice Smith license plate, chair pattern from Alethea Ballard DreamChairQuilts

Maker - Marilyn Knepp & Glenna Schweitzer Quilter - Laura Jarvis, Kootsi Quilting Marilyn & Glenna Do Gwen (Marston) and Freddy (Moran) Wall 69 x 69

Year-long collaborative quilt project by two great friends taking inspiration from the collaborative quilt books by Freddy Moran and Gwen Marston. Colors, parts and layout were all ironed out with close agreement and total enjoyment.

Pine Trees for Two 26 x 74 Wall

This pattern is from the Ann Arbor Sewing Center. I made two of these wall hangings, one for each daughter, to hang near their front doors where they both have a space. They will receive them at Thanksgiving so the wall hangings may be used during the upcoming holidays.

Maker - Jan Kosko Quilter - Jan Kosko

0 35 x 15.5 The Forest Wall

This pattern is from a Frieda Anderson class I took through the guild. I have enjoyed making it several times for friends who have admired mine. This one will be a gift to my sister Judy. She has a cabin Up North and will be perfect there.

60 x 80 SH For Sale **Teapot Round Robin**

The center square of the quilt was created in a round robin challenge within the 8 Mile Radius small group. Since the teapot was from the Safe House table its destiny was set. I sewed the checkerboard, teacups, border, and quilted it.

I found some pretty blocks in a box of fabrics donated to the GAAOG SafeHouse table. I made a few more coordinating blocks so that this could be a fun two-sided quilt. I am not an expert quilter, but I would be proud to bestow this on a young person in my family. The "other" side is very similar except the sashing is pinkish orange rather than pink floral.

Country Lanes 60.5 x 82 Bed

I have probably made 15 quilts from this design, each different, depending upon contrast between fabrics. The original design showcased solid pastel fabrics, but I tend to have prints on hand. I like to combine them with texturized solids and really like the end result. This particular quilt hangs in my dining room, and seems to glow with the diagonal rows of gold and blue squares against the dark floral background. Typically I would bind it with a darker color, but really like the effect of the gold fabric.

Based on "Country Lanes" in the book Mountain Mist Quilt Favorites, the dog print is set against a teal/ gold texture print background (Stonehenge Solstice). I almost used bright hues for the crosshatch lanes, rather than black and white, but I'm glad I went with the black and white. I had been away for a month, so ended up making the guilt start-to-finish in 3 days to get it into the show.

Maker - Camie Roper Quilter - Camie Roper

Windblown Tulips 20.5 x 20.5 Wall

Although this is only one block, the original pattern appears in the book Mountain Mist Quilt Favorites (Oxmoor House, Birmingham, 1998). A Kathy Patrick of Nicholasville, KY in 1983 made a full-size quilt with 12 blocks and a beautiful tulip-appliqued border, photographed for the book. The pattern first appeared on Mountain Mist batting wrappers in 1930, designed by Phoebe Edwards, who created and styled more than 50 guilt patterns for Mountain Mist from 1929-1937.

Maker - Camie Roper Quilter - Thread Bear Quilting 47.5 x 60 Cats & Bubbles Wall

I modified the block to make the design I wanted, then used only authentic cat colors in the blocks.



Maker - Janet Rost Quilter - Janet Rost

On the Bright Side 94 x 94 Bed

American Patchwork and Quilting held an online guilt-along starting in September of 2019. The pattern (On the Bright Side) was in their February 2018 issue. There are 256 three-inch sawtooth stars (17 pieces each) and was a big challenge for me. I quilted in during the pandemic and am glad to have completed the challenge.

Pandemic Posies 22 x 26 Wall

This guilt was started in a class taught by Maria Shell during the Houston Quilt Show of 2018. The pandemic gave me time to add hand stitches and machine quilting. Note the quilted "coronaviruses" in the background, each one embroidered with a slash of X's. In effect, these beautifully unique posies emerged from the pandemic and tamed the evil coronavirus.

Color Outside the Lines 59 x 59 Wall

All People Quilt/Quilts and More sponsored their 2019 online quilt-along. The pattern was created by Linda and Carl Sullivan of Quiltworks. I used stash fabrics similar in color to the kit fabrics. There were many points to match and I found it quite challenging. Online quilt-alongs are fun for me because they have a forum for asking questions, sharing photos and information, and congratulating other quilters on their work.

Maker - Brenda Quilter - Brenda Rowley Gray 9 x 9.5 Swimsuit on the Beach Wall

Completed in 2018 for a AAMQG color challenge. Beth Billup's encaustic work was the inspiration for this quilt.

Maker - Meena Schaldenbrand Ouilter - Meena Schaldenbrand COVID-19 Frenzy 24 x 30

Vocabulary: Social Distancing, Flattening Curve, Herd Immunity. Made face masks. Grateful: First Responders. Quarantine: lost some freedoms. Hoarded toilet paper, hand sanitizers, washed hands. How long will it last?
