Ann Loveless is a Frankfort, Michigan quilt artist who captures the beauty of Northern Michigan in her art quilts. Ann has a clothing and textile degree with an emphasis in art from Michigan State University. She has had a love of sewing and fabric all her life and since 2005 has found her calling in art quilts, particularly landscape quilts. Her subject matter in her quilts includes birch trees, flowers, ferns sunsets, sparkling water and snow and many other favorite nature scenes. Ann's inspiration and designs come from nature and the beautiful lakes and woods of northwest and the UP in Michigan. Her use of color, batik fabrics, yarns, tulle, angelina fiber, linen, gauze and lots of thread gives her designs texture and depth. Ann works from photographs and has developed three distinctive quilting techniques to express herself – collage, mosaic and impressionistic. Ann has had 15 quilts accepted in national juried quilt shows around the country. Ann was accepted into the 2008 Michigan Governor's artist residency program. Ann has had numerous public and private commissions.
