

LAKE MOSAIC SUPPLY LIST

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Greater Ann Arbor Quilt Guild
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DESCRIPTION

We will make a 7 inch x 10 inch "Lake" fabric mosaic landscape art quilt. It will involve cutting and fusing fabrics to create a background. Additional cutting and fusing of trees and leaf fabrics to create a northern Michigan lake scene. It will be free-motion machine quilted.

SUPPLY LIST:

Iron and ironing surface

Backing fabric : muslin 7x10 inches

Fusible interfacing 7x10 inches, woven or pellon

1/2 yard of Steam-a-seam (or 1 pkg. of "sheets" at JoAnn Fabrics) If you can not find steam-a-seam, pellon fusible web is second choice from JoAnn's.

Rotary cutter, mat and straight edge ruler

Fabric scissors

Glue stick

Black med. sharpie

FREE-MOTION QUILTING SUPPLIES

Sewing machine

Needles 90/14 topstitch

Embroidery foot (free-motion foot or darning foot)

Various machine embroidery threads : brown, black, white, gray, lt. yellow or lavender, green (light, medium & dark), Variegated threads are great.

60 wt. bobbin thread to match backing or gray. Or whatever works best in your machine.

Extension cord & thread stand (optional)

FABRICS: (bring scraps: batiks are great, variety rather than quantity)

Sunset sky colors: 10-15 lt. blue

Hill: 8-10 dark green & brown

Water: 10-15 shades of blue, dark and med.

Ground: 10-15 shades of mossy green and brown

Leaves: 4-6 bright and dark green

Tree trunks: 3-4, black, brown, birch

Grass: 2-3 gold and green
