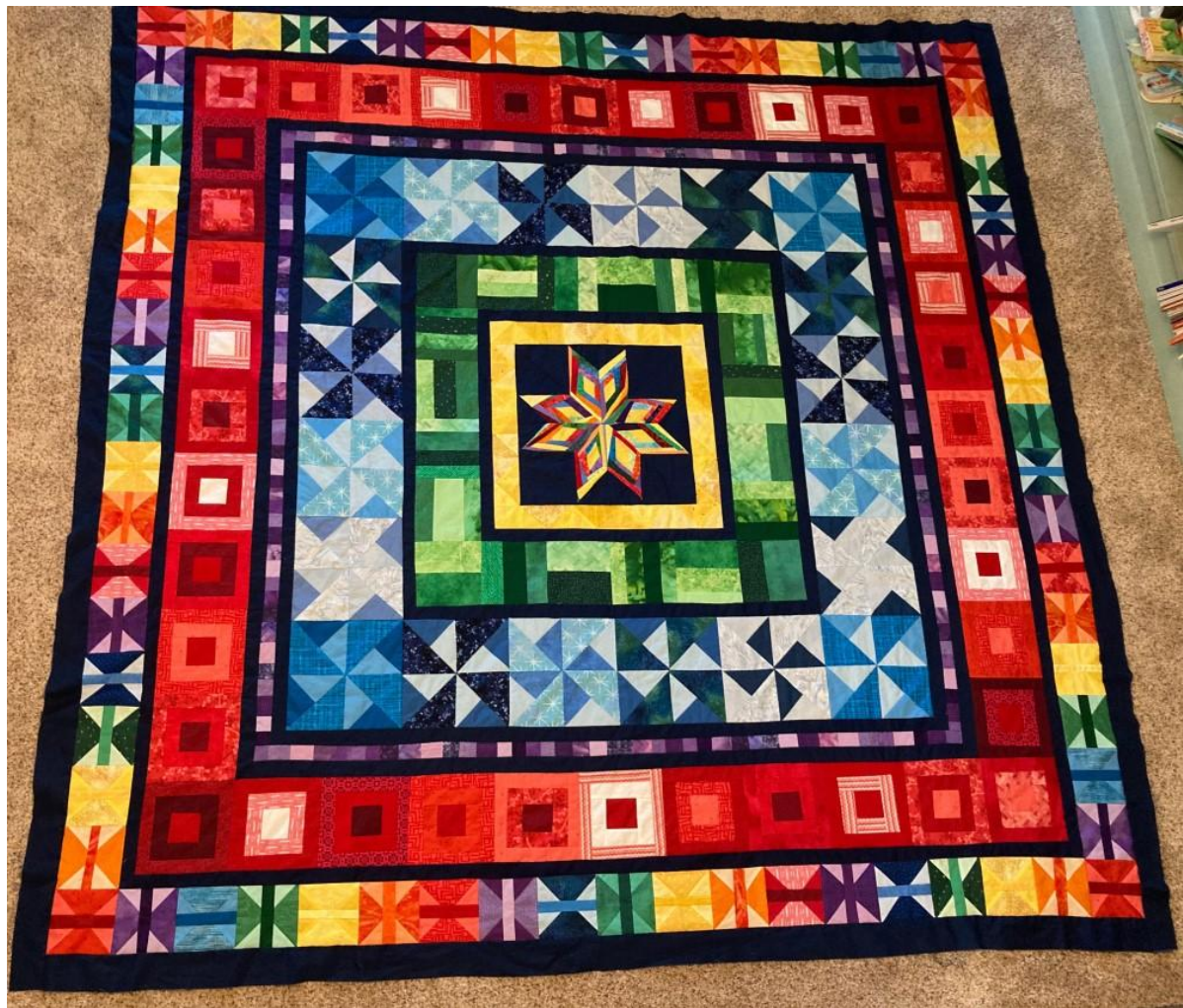
Attached is a photo of where I am
