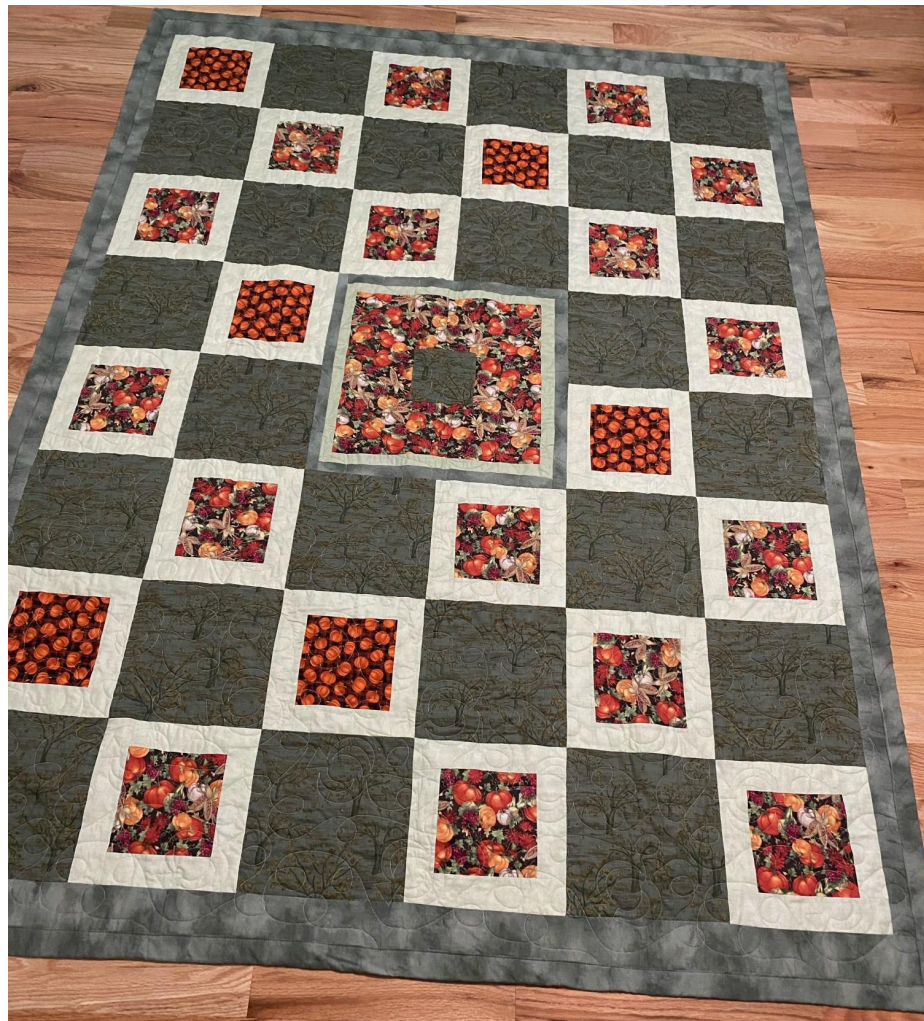

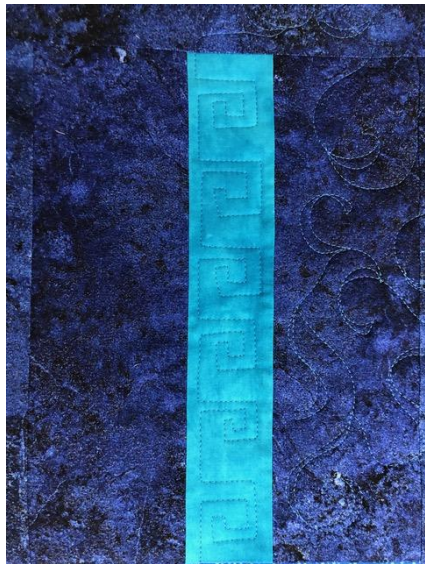
I followed along with Nico's Aviatix group. But too much fabric and not enough time resulted in this design. Made by Merrie and quilted by Laura Jarvis.

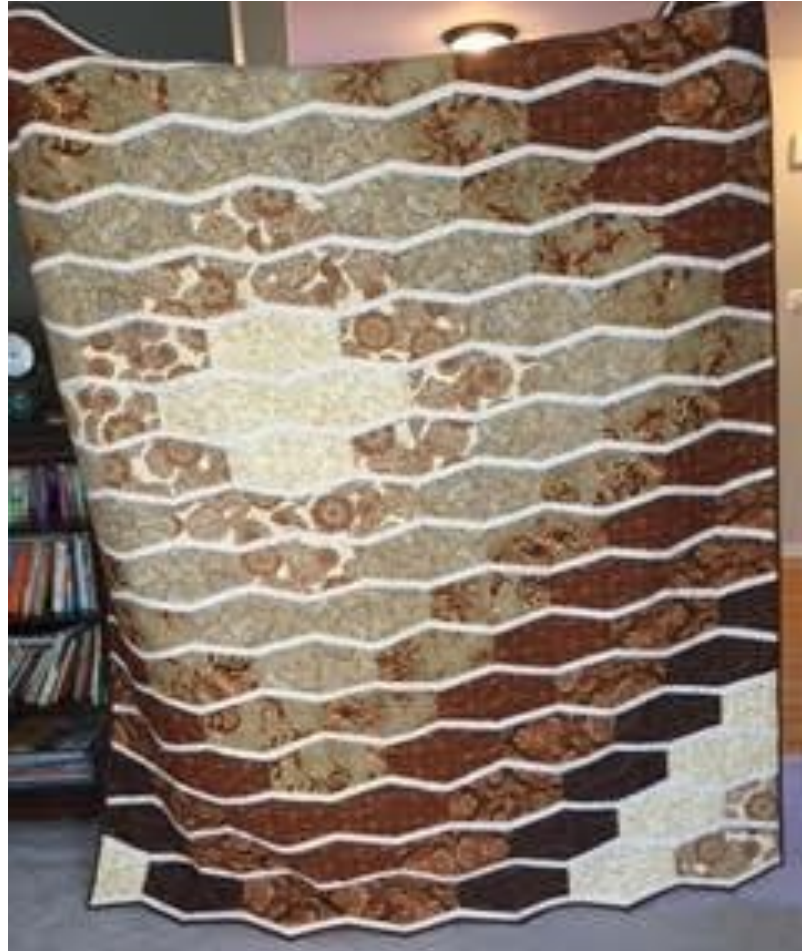

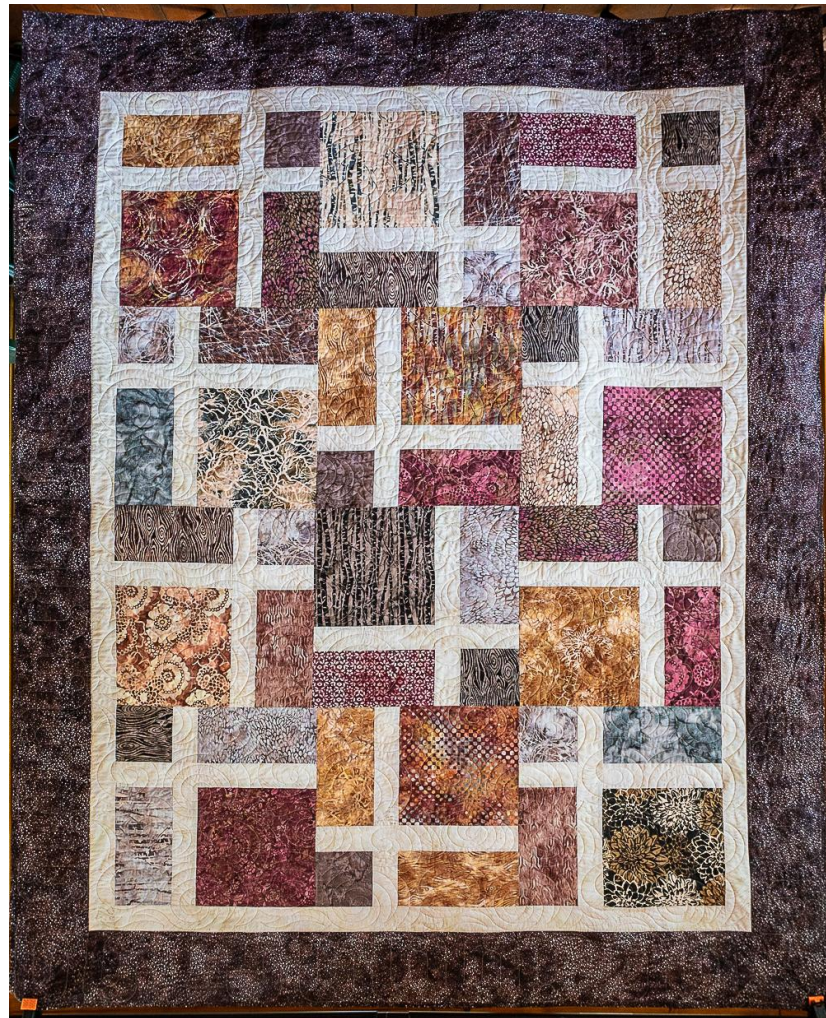
This bluejean quilt with plaid flannel back was made and quilted by a former GAAQG member. She made it and is giving it for SAFE House.
