## Supply List for Irene Roderick's Workshop: "Dancing With the Wall Quick-Step"

- Sewing machine and all stuff that goes with sewing: scissors, thread, sharp rotary cutter, cutting mat (as large as you can fit in your car-small ones are hard to work on), pins for pinning pieces together and for putting onto design wall
- Quilting rulers if you want. I am not a quilting ruler prohibiter. I like my 6.5x24'' but a 4x14'' works just fine.
- -2 yards each of two contrasting 100% cotton fabric that play together nicely. I suggest solids or prints that read as solids. You can throw in some "pop" colors in small amounts (scraps) if you want.
- -Spray starch, or Fresh Press or something similar. Stiff improv pieces behave much better!
- -Marking pens (disappearing type)
- -Design wall, at least  $48" \times 60"$ . Design walls can be white or off-white flannel or batting taped to the wall, flannel-backed tablecloths or portable design walls. These can also serve as a vehicle for taking your work home. I just use t-pins to attach the batting and then can remove it easily.
- -Any other of your favorite quilting tools.

No kits or patterns are required for this class
