

BECOME AN IMPROV EXPERT! Supply List:

Basic sewing supplies, thread in a neutral color, rotary cutter, ruler and mat, sewing machine.

Fabric required: The nature of this class is experimental, so exact fabric amounts cannot be determined. You should bring a minimum of 6 half-yard pieces that play well together. Usually that means a focus fabric, a light, a dark and 3 mediums, but you can pick anything that you like!

You may also bring any scraps that you would like, and larger pieces are better.

As we move from simple improv into more deliberate design, you may want to have coordinating fabrics in order to plan on an entire large art quilt. The samples also used about a yard of a compatible background. You should plan on an extra 1/2 yard or yard of a neutral to use for playing. Feel free to bring more fabric, or larger pieces if you are unsure about which ones you want to play with. A small wall hanging can easily be made from a few fat quarters and by using 6-8 half-yards you have a tremendous amount of leeway in what you make!

It is extremely helpful to have a design wall with this type of work. A large piece of batting will work, or fleece or even an extra chunk of fabric. Finished size of batting needed will be determined by the final shape of your design.

Backing will be determined by the final shape and size of your design.

Optional items: Square rulers of various sizes (we will share!), sense of adventure and do not forget your sense of humor!
